The camper patch may be purchased by Troop requisition after the Scout has camped with his Troop.

The segments and their requirements are as follows:

HIGH ADVENTURE SEGMENT	Participant in either a Council High Adventure program, or National High Adventure Base.
CAMP TAHOSA SEGMENT	Attend Camp Tahosa and accumulate two days and nights in camping at Camp Tahosa.
PEACEFUL VALLEY SEGMENT	Attend summer camp at Peaceful Valley for at least one summer session or accumulate six days and nights in weekend camping at Peaceful Valley.
WINTER CAMPING	During the months of December, January or February, using the Scout method of camping, camp out at least two consecutive days and nights.
CAMPOREE SEGMENT	Be in official attendance, camping with your Troop, in a district or Council Camporee.
CIVIC SERVICE SEGMENT	Perform 25 hours of civic service as authorized by Troop leaders, Council or Scoutmaster.
CONSERVATION SEGMENT	Perform a minimum of 20 hours service on conservation projects as authorized by Troop leaders, or Scoutmaster.

The camper patch may be worn upon presentation. Segments of course, will not be worn until the camper patch has been earned and presented.

A bronze star may be added to any segment to indicate each additional time a person has qualified for that segment.

The camper patch, segments and bronze stars may be purchased at the Scout Shop.
